**Re: Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court to dispose off the
Endosulfan Case**

Dear Sir,

This refers to the Public Interest Litigation (PIL) filed in April, 2011, before the Hon'ble Supreme Court by the Democratic Youth Federation of India seeking a ban on Endosulfan citing health concerns.

On 13th May, 2011, the Hon'ble Supreme Court passed an ad-interim Order banning production, sale and use of Endosulfan. Accordingly, the Company stopped production and sale of Endosulfan.

By its Order dated 10th January, 2017, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has disposed off the PIL by directing the State Governments to release the undisbursed amount of compensation to the affected persons within three months. The said Order also states that "Needless to mention, that it shall be open to the State Governments to recover the aforesaid compensation either from the concerned industry or from the Government of India, in case it is open to the State Governments to make such recovery, in consonance with law".

The Company has no stocks of Endosulfan.
